

2018 Lake Highlands Area Band Club Scholarship Student Application

The LHABC established a scholarship fund to provide a \$1,000.00 scholarship to up to six Lake Highlands Band students graduating in June 2018, who are planning to enroll in a two-year or four-year institution of higher education in the fall semester immediately after high school graduation.

**Deadline: Wednesday, March 21 at 4:00pm

Students applying must meet the following criteria:

1. The student must be currently enrolled in one of the LHHS Bands
2. The student must have been enrolled in a LHHS Band class for at least three academic years
3. The student must have a cumulative high school GPA of 80 or above
4. The student must plan to enroll in a two-year or four-year institution of higher education in the fall semester immediately after high school graduation

One scholarship may be awarded to recognize each of six categories of LHHS Band achievement:

1. **Performance.** Awarded to the graduating senior who has demonstrated excellence in performance in a way that has strengthened the LHHS band program. This may be demonstrated by superior performances at solo and ensemble contests, outstanding recommendations by a private lesson instructor, extraordinary performances in LHHS band and ensembles, leading one's own section to be more musical, and/or performing with excellence in settings beyond the high school.
2. **Leadership.** Awarded to the graduating senior who has demonstrated outstanding leadership within the band program and beyond, demonstrated in both official and unofficial capacities, as a section leader, drum major, drill assistant, or member of the band. The recipient of this award will be a student who is recognized by both peers and faculty as a leader.
3. **Scholarship.** Awarded to the graduating senior who has demonstrated excellence in all areas of academics while also excelling as a band student. The student should have demonstrated a minimum GPA of 90 and excellence in scholarship not only in fine arts classes but also in the full spectrum of high school academic life.
4. **Spirit.** Awarded to the graduating senior who has demonstrated outstanding school spirit and pride in the LHHS band program. The recipient of this award will be a student who has inspired the whole band to do its best and to have pride in performance as a representative of the Lake Highlands community.
5. **Travis McGaughey Memorial Scholarship.** Awarded to the Senior who has demonstrated outstanding performance and pride in the LHHS Jazz program. This recipient of this award will have demonstrated quality performance in the Jazz band for at least two years and exhibited a love for the program.
6. **Jack Stewart Memorial Scholarship.** Awarded to the graduating senior who has exhibited the qualities remembered of this 2013 LHHS graduate: exceptional performance, leadership, scholarship, and character by an elite musician, high achieving academic scholar, and outstanding young adult.

Students should not indicate which of the scholarships they seek. Judges will designate the award categories.

1. Complete all pages of this application by typing or handwriting in BLACK ink.
2. Solicit at least 2 letters of recommendation, including one from a high school or junior high band director or private lesson instructor, and a second one from someone outside of band who knows you well.
3. On an attached sheet, write an essay of approximately 250 words (one page typed, double-spaced, 12 point font) that addresses the question, "How has LHHS Band shaped your life?"
4. Submit 5 collated and stapled sets of the application documents:
 - o Completed Student Application Form
 - o Completed Student Profile Form **or** Personal Resume
 - o High school transcript (unofficial copies)
 - o Essay
 - o Two letters of Recommendation
5. Completed applications are due to the Senior Counselors office no later than 4:00pm on Wednesday, March 21, 2018.
6. Recipients will be recognized at the LHHS Senior Awards Ceremony and Annual Band Banquet in May 2018.
